Our Programs



Families will begin by enrolling with Crossroads Academy into **Level One**. This is the basis for all other programs at CCA.

For those who are seeking additional

activities to enrich their homeschooling experience, we offer **Level Two** which consists of After School Sports, Band, and Friday School Classes! Our Friday School is a full day, 32 week course of K-12 enrichment taught by CCA staff; classes may include Bible, Art, Physical Education, and/or specialty subjects.

Lastly, **Level Three** is available to students 7th grade and above as an option to integrate core campus classes into your home school.

HOW TO APPLY:

All CCA families (Levels 1, 2 or 3) are required to complete a Crossroads Application available from the Office or online. Application to the program is subject to Administrative approval .

STUDENT PROCESSING FEE:

All CCA families (Levels 1, 2 or 3) are required to pay an annual non-refundable Processing Fee of \$250.00 per student at the time of enrollment. Tuition Fees are also due for Level 2 and 3 students. Additional Registration Fees apply for Level 3 students.

LEVEL 1 - \$250 PER STUDENT, PER YEAR

LEVEL 3— PAYS PER COURSE + REG. FEES

- Everything included in Level 1 plus....
- Jr/Sr High classes on the main campuses with our traditional school students.

There is no limit to the number of families that can enroll in the Level 1 program; however, we do reserve the right to limit the number of students in the Level 2 & 3 programs.

Registration priority is given to returning CCA students and their siblings.

Services offered [ie. field trips, hot lunches, sports, scouts, etc.] through Crossroads Home School Academy will require additional fees.

REGISTRATION FEES — LEVEL 3:

All level 3 students are required to pay a \$75.00 testing fee. Once approved for class enrollment, Registration Fees are paid per course.

Middle School \$85.00 per course.

High School \$95.00 per course. A \$150 Spiritual Camp Fee is an additional option for high school.

Testing and registration fees are non-refundable.

LEVEL 3 TUITION — PER COURSE

Middle School \$950.00 per course.

High School \$1,000.00 per course.

- The purchase of CCS Uniforms is required for all Level 3 Middle School students.
- High School Lab Fees will be assessed as needed for course selection.
- Need for Macbook Laptop is based on high school course selection.

Please note: Class selections cannot be made until after Aug 2, 2011 when enrollment availability is determined.

CCA is pleased to offer a new payment plan option. Level 2 and Level 3 families may pay tuition fees in 10 monthly payments. Level 3 families paying with an EFT plan will have a discounted rate on registration fees of \$10 per course.
