God has provided incredible times for Middle School (grades 6 – 8) this year!

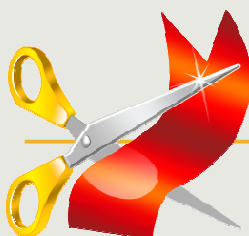
Middle School has grown to 170 full time students with an additional five students attending a selection of classes as Level 3 Crossroads Academy participants. The 2008-9 school year Middle School had 137 students. This year our program has grown by thirty-eight students (a growth rate of 22%)!

- Seventh grade has expanded to three classes & eighth grade has two classes. This growth has expanded the Team with Mr. Verner (Science), Mrs. Northcutt (Bible), & Miss Pervorse (Math/History).
