## FROM THE DESK OF ROGER HARRIS, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

### URGENT "FAMILY MEETING" - Friday, April 24, 7pm, in the Main Worship Center

It's time to call an urgent meeting of all the families of Crossroads Christian Schools — past and present. I am canceling the regular auction. (\*see the FYI under Master Calendar K-8 below). It's important that you hear the actual financial health of the schools and the hope we have for their future. If this sounds desperate, you need to know the facts.

Do we have hope? You bet - and it all resides in God's power and direction. I am asking everyone to join me and our staff in praying for the next 30 days, seeking God's wisdom and direction before we come together on the 24<sup>th</sup>, (Proverbs 3:5-6). Crossroads Christian Church, Church Development Fund (CDF) and others are rallying around our situation to help bring a solution.

Please clear your calendar. This is an evening for our present families, alumni and church families. I am also asking you to invite anyone you know who has a heart to see education with Christian principles succeed. After a time of worship and prayer, Pastor Chuck Booher and I will be sharing. It will be great to have everyone there so together we can experience another God-sized miracle!

### SAT TESTING

In order to be good stewards of our budget this year we will be administering the SAT tests to grades 3, 5 and 8 only. Typically, we administer this standardized test from grades 1-8, and will do so again in the future. Testing these benchmark grade levels will give us a good evaluation on the effectiveness of our program and curriculum (the main purpose of standardized testing), and will provide individual scores for students leaving the primary grades, elementary school, and middle school. This adjustment in testing practice will save us several thousand dollars for the 08-09 school year.
